


Get involved, build the future

2018 CATS STATISTICS

The Commercial Advancement Training Scheme has taken on students since it's inception in 2005. There have been a total of 134 recorded CATS students to date. 125 students have graduated the programme with 8 graduating in September 2018.


CATS Graduated Students




The following charts look at the number of students that have been selected for the program between 2010-2017.

The below graph details which companies took on students respectively.




In 2011 a total of 20 students were taken on by various member companies. The graphs illustrates the number of students each member company offered training to.




In 2012 a total of 17 students were placed. The year 2011 & 2012 saw
A decline in the number of students sponsored from 23 in the year 2010
to 20 and 17 in the years 2011 and 2012 respectively.


The number of member companies had not changed at this point and so no correlation between the number of companies and the intake number could be determined.




In 2013, 14 students got training placement. This was 3 students less than the previous year.




In 2014 a total of 17 students were placed. The increase of 3 students Compared to the pervious year was attributed to the membership Of a new company.




In 2015 a total of 14 students received training placement. CATS experienced the lowest number of active member companies at only 7 companies taking on students that year.




In 2016, 12 students received training placement within 9 member companies.



In 2017 a total of 17 students were awarded with training placements.




In 2018 a total of 23 students were awarded with training placements.



*Summary of CATS placement between 2010 & 2018


CATS student intake from 2010-2018






CATS Induction Stats

*The evaluations were completed by the 18 students that attended the workshop.




CATS Graduate Stats

The following charts aim to illustrate the number of graduates per training company from the year 2014 to 2017. *Please note that the 2010 graduation stats were not available


In 2014 a total of 7 students graduated from the CATS program.

2014 Graduates




In 2015 a total of 13 students graduated from various training companies. Transworld Cargo and PW Motors had the highest number of graduates that year.




In 2016 a total of 21 students graduated from the various training companies. Transworld Cargo had the highest number of graduates for that year.






In 2017 a total of 15 students are expected to graduate from various training companies.






In 2018 a total of 8 students are expected to graduate from various training companies.







CATS Tracer Study Results: 2015




This chart provides some detail about the alumni's that responded to the 2017 tracer study thus far.

CATS Tracer Study 2017: Demographics




This chart provides detail about the positions in which the respondents are as well as the length of time they have been employed.

This last chart illustrates the value placed on CATS by the Alumni. Majority of the alumni feel that the CATS program is a better alternative to academic studies amongst other points.






CATS 2017 Teambuilding


The focus on these statistics was to illustrate the interest for a teambuilding function by the CATS students. The value that the students hold for team building functions is understood and illustrated through these stats.

What is the typical response when CATS says they have organized a team building event




86% of the students are excited about teambuilding functions.

There were a total of 25 students at the 2017 teambuilding function of which only 22 completed the questionnaire.




There is a 87% satisfaction rate with the overall event and 78% of the students felt that the teambuilding met the objective of creating a team spirit. The least appreciated aspect of the teambuilding was the design of the activities with 57% of the students rating it as simply good and not very good.



57% of the students that attended the teambuilding were female. The 2017 tracer study has also illustrated that 59% of the CATS graduates have been female including the 2017 graduates.
